

## POSTER COMPETITION – HENAAC 2018



CAHSI will be reviewing and approving abstracts eligible for the poster competition at the HENAAC conference. CAHSI Students with an approved abstract and approved funding will receive a code that will waive registration cost.

\*\*The abstract review process will take 2-3 weeks. \*\*

### ELIGIBILITY

- Graduate and undergraduate students from a CAHSI institution
- Must be from an underrepresented ethnic/racial group. CAHSI will give priority to Hispanic students.
- Must be registered full-time in a computing related major (Doctoral candidates do not have to be full time)
- Eligibility and selection is based upon each CAHSI institution's available budget. Additional support will be confirmed as funding becomes available.

### CAHSI DEADLINES

- **Aug 20- Sept 14** CAHSI Abstract Submissions - Open for Review
- **Sept 14** Registration deadline to be considered for a GMiS Travel Grant – **Strongly recommended**
- **Oct 5** Registration closes

### CAHSI SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS AND REGISTRATION DEADLINES

1. Your submission needs to adhere to the guidelines provided by Great Minds in STEM (GMiS) in the following link: <http://www.greatmindsinstem.org/pdf/2018/2018%20Research%20Posters%20Competition%20Guidelines-080718.pdf>
2. Submit **you abstract and resume** using the CAHSI Poster Submission System: <https://cahsiposter.utep.edu/>
3. You will receive a notification via email with your abstract status within 2-3 weeks. Your institution will provide a registration waiver once your abstract is approved.
4. Please resubmit any requested abstract changes within 3 days for final approval.
5. ONLY when your abstract is approved by CAHSI, then you MUST register for the poster competition using your registration waiver and submit final approved abstract using the following link: <http://www.cvent.com/events/2018-great-minds-in-stem-research-posters-competition/event-summary-e512b776e1db407d9ec18ccda447a0bc.aspx>. Final Deadline: **October 5**. CAHSI will not support any abstracts submitted without CAHSI review.
6. Follow GMiS guidelines provided in step #1 to develop your poster. Faculty mentors MUST review/approve poster before the competition. Students are responsible printing their posters 15 days prior to travel.
7. Only the authoring student may present his/her work at the conference. No substitutions will be allowed under any condition.
8. Poster presenters will be provided with a display that stands 8 Ft. (wide) x 4 Ft. (tall). Presenters MUST bring at least 10 copies of their abstracts for the judges.
